Ceasession of Membership in Co-operative Housing Society

As per the old Bye-laws (2001) of the Co-operative Housing Society there are three types of Members of the Society,

- 1. Member
- 2. Associate Member of the Society and
- 3. Nominal Member of the Society.

A Member will ceased to be a member under the following circumstances.

- 1. On acceptance of resignation of the member.
- 2. On transfer of his share and the interest in capital/ property of the society.
- 3. On the death of Member.
- 4. When a member is declared insolvent.
- 5. When where about of member are not known for continues 7 years and his shares and interest in the capital property of the society is not claimed by anybody.
- 6. When right, title and interest of members in the society ceases on legal attachment or sale.

The Society's Managing Committee is required to record the **Ceasession** of Membership in the minutes and the Hon. Secretary has to inform the Member about the decision of the Committee.
