## **Ceasession of Nominal Membership**

A Nominal Member is a person who occupies the flat on behalf of a partnership firm, a company or any other body corporate who may be member of the society.

The Nominal Members ceases to be such member of the society under the following circumstances.

- 1. **Ceasession** of a membership of the firm company, corporate body.
- 2. On expulsion of original Member.
- 3. On the original Member terminating the Nomination.
- 4. On acceptance of resignation of Nominal Member by the Managing Committee.
- 5. On the death of Nominal Member.

The Managing Committee has to record the facts of **Ceasession** of Membership of the Nominal Members in the minutes of the meeting and the Secretary of the Society has to inform the concerned member within a day of the decision of the committee.
