

Ceasession of Nominal Membership

A Nominal Member is a person who occupies the flat on behalf of a partnership firm, a company or any other body corporate who may be member of the society.

The Nominal Members ceases to be such member of the society under the following circumstances.

1. **Ceasession** of a membership of the firm company, corporate body.
2. On expulsion of original Member.
3. On the original Member terminating the Nomination.
4. On acceptance of resignation of Nominal Member by the Managing Committee.
5. On the death of Nominal Member.

The Managing Committee has to record the facts of **Ceasession** of Membership of the Nominal Members in the minutes of the meeting and the Secretary of the Society has to inform the concerned member within a day of the decision of the committee.
